Course Description (structure/delivery)

YEAR 11 COURSE

No previous experience is required: you can be either a complete beginner or have up to 100 hours' previous experience in French.

Students will: express and share ideas that relate to their daily lives and undertake activities and transactions in communities where French is spoken.

Topics covered include:

YEAR 12 COURSE

Much the same as the Year 11 course, with more focus on Speaking & Writing skills.

Tasks involved:

Listening: interviews, role-plays, advertisements, announcements, messages, conversations & news items.

Reading: messages, notes, emails, newspaper & magazine extracts, reports, surveys, letters, postcards.

Speaking: oral presentations, interviews, role-plays.

Writing: produce messages, letters, emails, postcards, notes, articles, diary entries & scripts.
