Course Description

YEAR 11 COURSE

Learning opportunities focus on:

- The nature of practice in art making, art criticism and art history.
- The role and function of artists, artworks, the world and audiences in the art world.
- The different ways the visual arts are interpreted and how students might develop their own informed points of view.
- Building understandings through various investigations and working in different forms.

YEAR 12 COURSE

- Developing students' own practice of art making, art criticism and art history, applied to selected areas of interest.
- Developing students' informed points of view in increasingly independent ways and use of different interpretive frameworks in their investigations.
- Developing deep understanding of the relationships between artists, artworks, the world and audiences within the artworld.
- Assisting students to further develop meaning and focus in their work.
