Why study Biology?

Biology develops students' understanding of Science as a continually developing body of knowledge, the role of experimentation in deciding between competing theories, the nature of scientific explanations, the interdisciplinary nature of Science, the complex relationships between evidence and ideas and the impact of Science on society.





Course Description (structure/delivery)

YEAR 11 COURSE:

Students will undertake four modules:

Module 1: Cells as the Basis of Life

Module 2: Organisation of Living Things

Module 3: Biological Diversity **Module 4:** Ecosystem Dynamics

YEAR 12 COURSE:

Students will undertake four modules:

Module 5: Heredity

Module 6: Genetic Change
Module 7: Infectious Disease
Module 8: Non-Infectious Disease

The Biology Syllabus essentially explores Life Past, Present and in the Future. It has a focus on hands on learning through experimentation which is accentuated by the mandatory Field Study and Depth Study components of the Course.

In Year 11 you will experience an ecosystem study in the local area and in Year 12 we will provide HSC preparation experiences including an excursion and lecturer from a variety of providers/ Universities.
