### Student Computer Accounts

Generally, within 48 hours of attending your first day at CHSC, you will be able to access the computer resources at the Coffs Harbour Education Campus. There are two main computer accounts you require to be able to login (they have SEPARATE usernames/passwords):

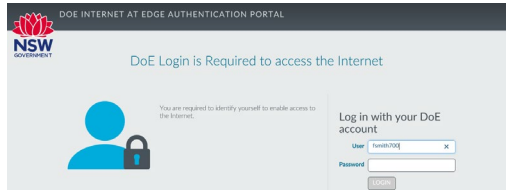
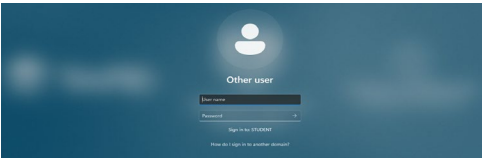
1. CHEC Login Account (1<sup>st</sup> login for on-campus lab computers + print/copy/scan + DOE Internet To Edge Portal)
2. DOE Login Account (Proxy Login/Email/WiFi/Student Portal/Stile)

#### 1. CHEC Login Account

To access the computer lab facilities, including printers/photocopiers & http://printpay.scu.edu.au website, you have an on-campus password.

NOTE: THIS IS THE **FIRST** LOGIN BOX THAT YOU WILL BE PRESENTED WITH ON-CAMPUS COMPUTERS/PRINTERS PLUS 2<sup>ND</sup> LOGIN ON WIFI



Username = first initial of your first name + first five characters of your surname + the number 700  
e.g. John Smithville is jsmith700 or John Fox jfox700

NOTE: If you are the 2<sup>nd</sup> student with the same name then your number will increase by one eg. Jane Smith jsmith701, etc

Initial Password = your 8 digit DOB (ddmmyyyy)

To access the Proxy Internet/Email/WiFi/Student Portal/Stile

# How To Login To On-Campus Computers @ CHEC

 NOTE: YOU'LL NEED TO PERFORM THIS ON EACH COMPUTER YOU USE AT CHEC

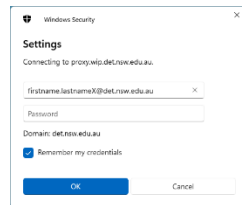
1. Type in your **CHEC Lab Login Account** details, e.g. jsmith700
2. Click on the **arrow** button
3. FIRSTLY, click on Search , type anything 
4. Login with **firstname.lastname@detnsw** for username & password (same as Stile, Student Portal, Email)
5. After this, you can then use any application, e.g. Chrome



## Sign Out (Log Off)

1. Make sure all programs and windows are closed
2. Hold CTRL + ALT + DELETE on the keyboard
3. Click on the **Sign Out** option
4. Wait until the screen appears with the date & time before leaving the computer

You can also go to:  
Open Windows Credentials  
Click "Add a Windows credential"  
Type proxy.wip.det.nsw.edu.au  
**Go to Step 4**



*(This ensures that it has logged off correctly and you can login to another computer)*



## Wireless (WiFi)

To connect to **free** on-campus WiFi;

### WINDOWS LAPTOP

1. Connect to DETNSW
2. Username: Enter your DOE Account Username (firstname.lastnameX@detnsw)  
Password: Enter your DOE Account Password
3. Click on Connect
4. Launch a web browser, go to <http://detnsw.net>
5. Login using your CHEC username and Password (e.g. fsmith700)

### MACINTOSH LAPTOP

1. Choose Apple menu > System Preferences and then select Network
2. Join DETNSW
3. Enter your DOE portal credentials (firstname.lastnameX@detnsw) and Select "Join"
4. Click on "Continue" when the authentication prompt appears
5. Enter the local administrator username and Password and click on "Update Settings"
6. Select "OK/Apply" the setup is now complete
7. Launch a web browser, go to <http://detnsw.net>
8. Login using your CHEC username and Password (e.g. fsmith700)

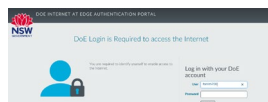
### MOBILE DEVICE



1. Go to Settings, Tap on Wi-Fi, choose DETNSW
2. Enter the following:
  - Phase-2 authentication: Select MSCHAPV2
  - Identity: Enter your DOE Account Username (e.g. john.smithville1@detnsw)
  - Password: Enter your DOE Account Password
3. Tap Connect
4. Launch a web browser, go to <http://detnsw.net>
5. Login using your CHEC username and Password (e.g. fsmith700)
1. Go to Settings
2. Tap on Wi-Fi
3. Switch Wi-Fi ON and choose DETNSW
4. Enter your DOE Login Account Username & Password e.g. john.smithville1@detnsw
5. Tap Join button
6. Click Accept/Trust
7. Launch a web browser, go to <http://detnsw.net>
8. Login using your CHEC username and Password (e.g. fsmith700)

 NOTE:

- YOU WOULD HAVE TO CHANGE YOUR CHEC LOGIN ACCOUNT FROM YOUR DOB TO SOMETHING BEFORE GOING TO <http://detnsw.net>
- IF YOU CAN'T BROWSE THE INTERNET CLOSE YOUR BROWSER AND LOGIN TO <http://detnsw.net> AGAIN
- IF YOU ARE USING CHROME AND LOGIN DOESN'T APPEAR OPEN EDGE/SAFARI LOGIN, THEN CHROME



## Student Email

From the Student Portal (<http://student.det.nsw.edu.au>), click on the Email link (top right corner).

What is my email address? It is your DOE Login Account username followed by @education.nsw.gov.au e.g. john.smithville1@education.nsw.gov.au

## DOE Student Portal

The Student Portal (<http://student.det.nsw.edu.au>), allows you to set up your timetable. It also allows you to access your student email, links to both Microsoft 365 and Google Drive.

You are also able to access downloads available free from Adobe.

From here, you will have access to your College timetable, daily notices and reports when published.

## Microsoft Office For Home

Enrolled DOE students can access **free** Microsoft Office for personal/home use on their own personal devices (up to 5 devices tablets & laptops).

- Sign in to OneDrive <https://onedrive.live.com/about/en-us/signin/> using your DOE email address
- You will be taken through the verification process you will be asked to provide your DOE username and password
- Then you will be able to download & install the software.

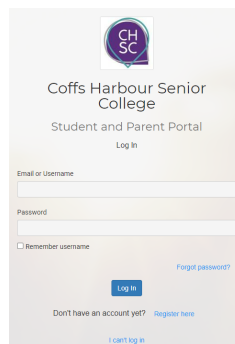

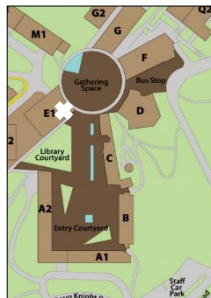

## Computer Labs

The labs are located on the first two levels of A2 Block (timetables are on each door). There are also computers in the Library + E.G.19 (under Library) in E1 Block.

\* You can also book (<http://libcal.scu.edu.au>) a study room on Level 2 of the Library. These rooms have no permanent computers, but you can borrow a laptop from the Library desk. Each room has a wall-mounted monitor for connecting your own or Library laptops.

### **A Block Computer Lab Hours**

7:30am – 5:00pm Monday to Friday  
5:00pm – 11:00pm Monday to Friday via swipe card  
8:00am – 5:00pm Saturday & Sunday via swipe card

- Ensure you organise swipe card (after-hours) access to the computer labs.
- Application forms are available from the Technology Service Desk(E.G.19). You will need to complete one of these forms at the beginning of each year.
- The after-hours labs are A.G.6 – A.G.8.

### **Print/Copy/Scan**

To be able to print/copy/scan you will need to do the following first:

1. Obtain a CHEC student ID card from Admin
2. Login to a CHEC Lab Computer (A2/E1 Block) & if prompted, change the password
3. Register card at the printer/copier username = student\xxxxx700 – CHEC Lab Account (see page 1)
4. Add credit to your print card @
  - a. Equitrac Pay Station (Library), min 20c + a change machine is available at this location
  - b. From on-campus computers (A2/E1 Block) go to "Add Print Credit" (desktop shortcut) (PayPal/Credit or Debit Card \$5 to \$50) – CHEC Lab Account (see page 1)



Printing: Select FollowYou printer queue and release/collect your printing **within 3 hours**  
Instructions: Detailed instructions are available at the locations  
Locations: A.G.5-8 Foyer, A.G.9-12 Foyer, Outside A.1.24 and Library 1st + 2nd Floor, E.G.19
