A variety Distance Education Courses are offered. Conditions apply - library support available during student's study periods.

Some advice to students:

- To complete the HSC a student must complete a minimum of 22 units across the two years. 12 units in Year 11 and 10 units in Year 12. Some students choose more than this and may keep or discontinue these additional subjects as they progress. Other choose less and do a 'Pathways' (part-time) program over more than two years.
- Maintain your options - ensure that you have a range of subjects to extend into the HSC year.
