



Course Description (structure/delivery)

YEAR 11 COURSE

The Year 11 course is structured to provide students with opportunities to develop and apply their understanding of geographical concepts.

The course consists of four focus areas. These include:

- 2. People, patterns and processes
- 3. Human-environment interactions
- 4. Geographical Investigation.
