Additional Subject Offerings

TAFE Delivered Vocational Education and Training (TVET) Courses

A large number of TVET courses are offered by TAFE NSW. Please refer to separate TAFE Course Sheet.

Please ensure that you check the HSC and ATAR implications for individual courses. Rachel Fraser, our Careers Adviser can assist with selecting TVET courses.

Distance Education

A variety of Distance Education Courses are offered. Conditions apply - library support is available during student's study periods.

Some advice to students:

- To complete the HSC a student must complete a <u>minimum</u> of 22 units across the two years. 12 units in year 11 and 10 units in year 12. Some students choose more than this and may keep or discontinue these additional subjects as they go along.
- Students who choose less are on a 'Pathways' (part-time) program over more than two years.
- Maintain your options ensure that you have a range of subjects to extend into the HSC year, i.e. don't select a number of 1 year courses that will leave you short of units in year 12.
- Ensure that you have options for further training (either through TAFE or university) or employment.
