Suggestions for organisation of school work

This list specifies general stationery items you will be looking to purchase in the new year. Year 11 and Year 12 may be different to previous years, where all course work will be assessed in the final HSC exams at the end of two years of study. Most subjects request a lever arch folder with loose paper and plastic sleeves or an exercise book. If you have more than one subject that requires a folder we suggest that you have one 'working folder' for school with coloured dividers for different subjects. Once a unit of work is completed, it can be transferred to the appropriate subject specific folder at home. This will mean that only one folder needs to be brought to school each day and notes will be neatly organised for exam revision. When purchasing exercise books for subjects, please purchase the ones that can clip into the folder.

Additional equipment may be required from time to time and class teachers will advise of this as the need arises.
