We will be commencing full time face-to-face classes from **Monday 25 May**. Classes will continue next week with the current arrangement of Year 12s the first half of the week and Year 11s the second.

Students should refer to the timetable on the *Sentral* Student Portal for the correct classrooms.

Here is a summary of the changes you need to be aware of:

- 25 May – Year 11 & 12 students return to the normal timetable on campus. Some classrooms may be re-allocated to accommodate larger classes. Check *Sentral* Student Portal for changes. Cleaning of rooms will continue as per the current arrangements.
- 4 & 5 June – Year 12 only – Study and Assessment Window – no Year 12 classes on these days. Year 11 classes will continue as per the normal timetable.
- 8 June – Queen’s Birthday Public Holiday
- 16 June – Year 11 & 12 combined Mentor Session – 11am to 12pm. Classrooms to be advised on the day. Year 11s will receive their Mid Course Reports during this session.

- 24-26 June – Study and Assessment Window – no Year 11 & 12 classes on these days
